February 23, 1908 - July 22, 2013

Rose Libera Marone Ferrucci, 105, of Branford, formerly of Hamden, passed away peacefully at home on July 22, 2013.

Rose was born in New Haven on February 23, 1908 to the late Antonio and Rosa Riccio Marone. She was predeceased by her husband, Raffaele (Ralph) Ferrucci, her daughter, Rosemary Cassidy, her son-in-law, Edward G. Steinlauf, her granddaughter-in-law, Pamela Kibbee, and her siblings, Josephine Macolino and Pasquale, Angelo and John Marone.

Rose had a vast knowledge of American glassware and dishware, and was a thrifty, resourceful woman. One of her favorite pastimes was finding a bargain at the tag sales, flea markets and thrift shops she loved to frequent. She was a great fan of the Yankees and the UCONN Women's Basketball team, and was an avid reader. As a child, even before she could read, she would visit the New Haven Public Library to take books out on loan.

Home and family were most important to Rose. She had a deep connection to her birthplace, New Haven, and to her childhood home on Webster Street. In 1943, she and her husband moved to Hamden where Rose lived for 69 years. Three generations of the family lived in the Hamden home, and family and friends have many fond memories of the countless get-togethers and gatherings that took place in Rose's home.
