At home, Oct. 28, 2014, Alice Rose Masterson, 93, of Hamden. Born Feb 19, 1921 in New Haven a daughter of the late William and Anna Carney Masterson, she was a graduate of St. Mary's High School, the New York Stenotype Institute and the New York Court Reporting Institute. She was employed in the New Haven City Court and the New Haven Superior Court, subsequently appointed Official Court Reporter of that court. In 1979 when the courts merged, she was appointed Official Court Reporter of the Milford Superior Court, Judicial District of Milford/ Derby. A longtime parishoner of St. John the Baptist Church in Hamden she was a member of the church choir, a member of the church finance board and the St. John Ladies League. She also spent many hours doing volunteer work at the church. Alice was a founder of the CT Court Reporters Assoc.
