Anna B. Devlin was born in New Haven, CT. in 1927. The only girl in a family of three brothers, she enjoyed dancing and as a young lady performed as a tap dancing duo with her brother Peter Bradley. She graduated from St. Boniface High School but not before meeting her future husband, Edmund Devlin, to whom she wrote faithfully while he served his country in the U.S. Navy during WWII.
