Catherine Rose Nichols, 93 died quietly at Saint Raphael's Hosp. in New Haven on Friday, April 2, surrounded by her family. She is survived by her husband of 66 years, R. Richard "Dick" Nichols. She is also survived by her four children: Barbara Nichols of Hamden, Mark Nichols of New Haven, Rosemary Nichols of Branford and Denise Nichols of Hamden.
