May 25, 1918 - February 1, 2019

Margaret Elaine McKeon Buckley, widow of Christopher H. Buckley died on February 1, 2019. Born May 25, 1918 in Albany, N.Y., she was the daughter of Dr. Francis J. McKeon and Margaret Cross Rosselle McKeon. She was a graduate of the Albany Girls' Academy and the College of St. Rose, and also attended Wellesley College.

With her husband and children, she had lived for several years in North Haven, CT and later Scarsdale, NY. They returned to Connecticut in 1963 living in Cheshire where Mr. Buckley died in 1997. In 2002, she became a resident of Whitney Center in Hamden, CT and for four years was President of its Residents' Council and a member of its Board of Directors. She was a longtime member of the Quinnipiack Club and the New Haven Country Club.

She is survived by her daughter, Lucy Buckley Maloney-Walsh (Robert) of Greenwich, CT and Naples, Florida and by two sons Christopher H. Buckley (Marguerite) of Islamorada, Florida and Mclean, Virginia and Francis McKeon Buckley (Donna) of Marlborough, CT. Her youngest son, Mark Gerard Buckley died in 1964.
