Hugh McLean, Jr., 89, of Hamden passed away peacefully on February 10, 2014 with family by his side. He was born to the late Hugh and Margaret McLean of New Haven. Hugh is survived by his loving wife of 65 years, Jeanne along with his two sons, Hugh Scott McLean (Susan) of PA, and Brian McLean (Judi) of Clinton, CT. He is also survived by his three grandchildren whom he loved dearly Lauren, Sean and Sara, his sister-in-laws Carolyn Coleman and Marie McLean along with many nieces and nephews. Hugh was predeceased by his two sisters ; Dorothy (Padden), Margaret (Hunter) and brother Robert. A WWII and D-Day Veteran, he proudly served in the US Navy from 1942-1945 in North Africa and in the Allied invasions of Sicily and Normandy. He received the Alfred Ramelli Award (1973) and the Hamden Civitan Club Fireman of the Year Award (1982). He loved his career with the Hamden Fire Department, which provided many great memories and life long friends. Hugh found great joy and pride in caring for the home he built for his family.
