James F. "Poppy" McCabe, 83, of Wallingford, beloved husband of Patricia Sayers McCabe, passed away on February 10.

Jim was born in New York City on Dec. 17, 1933, the son of the late James B. and Elizabeth Reynolds McCabe. He served in the U.S. Army during the Korean conflict and was employed by Allegheny Ludlum Steel Corporation until his retirement. Jim was a parishioner of Our Lady of Fatima Church.

Besides his wife, Patricia, he is survived by his devoted children, Kelly McCabe Bibisi of Wallingford and twins, Jimmy McCabe of Meriden and Mary McCabe of Cromwell. "Poppy" shared a very special bond with his loving grandchildren, Meagan and Molly Bibisi whom he adored.

Jim's love of his Irish heritage – and indeed all things Irish - was contagious. He was an active member of the New Haven Gaelic Football and Hurling Club and Irish American Community Center, being named "Man of the Year" in 1999 for his accomplishments in promoting Irish culture and traditions. In later years he developed a great interest and knowledge of Irish genealogy, becoming a skilled genealogist for the Irish community.
