John E. Hansen, Sr (Jack) peacefully passed away, surrounded by his loving family, at home on Friday, June 18, 2021 at the age of 84. Jack was born on October 14, 1936 in New Haven, Connecticut to Edward S. and Mae (Gerard) Hansen. He attended Saint Francis Grade School and graduated from Wilbur Cross High School in 1954. He served two years in the US Navy. In 1962, he married Margaret (Margie) Donohue Hansen. Jack worked for many years at Cyclops-Detroit Steel in Hamden, followed by many more years at the Foote School in New Haven, where he was cherished and respected by staff and students alike. Besides his wife, he is survived by his children: Mary Reynolds and her husband, Jack, John Hansen, Jr. and partner Len Suzio, Elizabeth Case and her husband Tyson, David Hansen and his wife Britt, and Thomas Hansen and his former wife Jina. He also leaves behind 10 grandchildren: Meg, Lizzie, and Eileen Reynolds; Julia, Timothy and Taryn Case; Emma, Thomas, and Mikka Hansen, and Luke Ginieres. He is also survived by many lifelong friends, nephews, and nieces.
