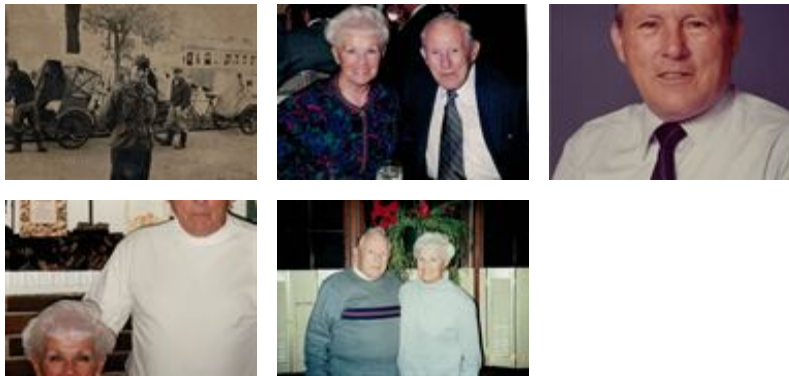
*Aunt Helen, JoEllen and Jay,

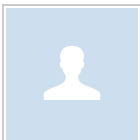


“ *Dear JoEllen and Bill:*
