



Joseph Levitzky

June 14, 1926 - October 9, 2010

Joseph J. Levitzky, of Hamden, Ct, passed away on October 9th 2010, after an extended illness. He was the dearly beloved husband for 53 years of the late Catherine Z. Levitzky and the most devoted father of Joseph M. Levitzky. Born on June 14, 1926 in New York City, NY, he was a son of the late Gregory and Barbara (Kozey) Levitzky. He is survived by his son, Joseph, and was predeceased by his brother, the Reverend Vladimir Levitzky, and his sister, Katerina Levitzky. He was a parishioner of St. Michael Ukrainian Catholic Church in New Haven and of St. Rita Roman Catholic Church in Hamden. He was member of the Holy Name Society and choir of St. Michael Church. A graduate of New York University and Yale University, with degrees in chemical engineering, and an MBA from the University of New Haven, he was first employed by GAF and then with the Olin Corporation, where his career spanned 30 years. While still with Olin, he became affiliated with the Chemical Engineering department at Yale, where he taught for 22 years. He was an elected Fellow of the American Institute of Chemical Engineers (AIChE) and a member of the American Chemical Society.
