Joseph A. Weisbruch, 66, of Hamden, passed away peacefully on May 4, 2026. Joseph was born to Joseph B. and Shirley J. Weisbruch on September 23, 1959, in Peoria, Illinois. Joe attended grade school and high school in Brimfield, Illinois. After graduating from high school, he earned a Bachelor's degree in Mechanical Engineering from Southern Illinois University Carbondale.

Joe began his career with Martin Marietta in New Orleans, where he worked for nine years, before joining Sikorsky Aircraft, where he dedicated the past 39 years of his career.

Joe enjoyed snow skiing with his daughter, Savannah. He was also an active member of the local Harley-Davidson club and would often say, "We rode long, hard, and had a great ride." Joe had a lifelong love of trains and built an impressive two-level HO train set measuring 10 by 20 feet.
