Marguerite was a library teacher at Fair Haven Jr. High School and then at Wilbur Cross High School from 1966 until her retirement in 1982. She was a member and president of the Albertus Magnus College Alumni Assoc., a member and officer of the Catholic Charity League, a member of the New Haven Federation of Teachers, the CT Assoc. of Retired Teachers, the New Haven Council of Catholic Women, the Ladies Guild of St. Joseph's Church and the Irish American Historical Society. She also was a volunteer in the St. Raphael's Hospital Gift Shop for twenty three years. Marguerite is survived by her Goddaughter, Stephanie Stiefel Williams of Guilford and a Godson, Thomas Frawley of St. James, NY.
