



Martha Klara Mulski

December 24, 1925 - March 1, 2017

Martha “Marthi” Klara Mulski, aged 91 , of Hamden CT passed away peacefully on the morning of March 1st, 2017. Born in Switzerland in 1925, to Josef and Karolina Breitenmoser, the second of four children: Lilly, Marthi, Klarli and Walti. She spent her youth in Chur and became an airline hostess for SwissAir in the 1950s where she traveled the world. She met her future husband, Francis “Pat” Mulski, in Thailand when he was a U.S. Naval officer. They were married in 1959, and Marthi came to the U.S. where she raised a family of six children: Claire, Michael, Carol, Linda, Patrick and Steven. During this time, the family spent 8 years in Ireland, a place Marthi felt as much a part of as anywhere she lived in her life. She spent the last 28 years helping to raise her 12 granddaughters, and visiting her family and friends in Europe and the U.S.

Marthi is fondly remembered as a loving, caring, deeply devoted mother, grandmother, sister and friend. She was a woman well ahead of her time, always considerate and inclusive of the various peoples that make up our society. She was an independent thinker and extremely discerning in her views. She had a keen insight into human nature and understood the complicated situations that made people who they are.

She will be sorely missed and remembered as a fine example of a life well lived.
