

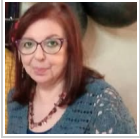


Mary Bonadies

October 24, 1934 - November 17, 2009

Mary Curello Bonadies of Hamden, CT, loving wife, mother, grandmother and teacher died peacefully at her home surrounded by her family on November 17th after a long illness with Progressive Supranuclear Palsy (PSP). She was 75. Wife of Anthony J. Bonadies and daughter of the late Elizabeth and John Curello she was born October 24, 1934 in New Haven CT. A 1956 graduate of New Haven State Teacher's College, a 1958 UConn Master's degree recipient and a passionate teacher all her life. Survivors include her husband Tony, and five children.
