Mary Elizabeth Hunt, 100, of Hamden, CT passed away peacefully at home surrounded by her loving family on Thursday, November 19, 2020. Mary was born in New Haven, CT on September 12, 1920 to the late Jeremiah and Johannah (Halloran) McCarthy.
