July 31, 1945 - June 7, 2025

It is with heavy hearts that we announce the passing of Mary Jo Pohl, age 79, of Hamden, CT, on June 7, 2025, at Yale New Haven Hospital, surrounded by love. Born on July 31, 1945, in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, Mary Jo carried the warmth and resilience of her hometown with her throughout her life.

lovingly called her "Nana." Her kindness, strength, and generous spirit live on in each of them.

She was predeceased by her parents, Joseph and Audrey Dwyer, and her younger brother, Patrick Dwyer. She is survived by her brother, James Dwyer, and many dear friends and extended family members whose lives were touched by her warmth and grace.
