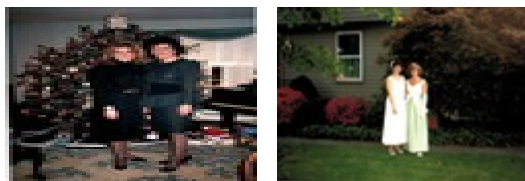
“ Dear Keniry Family,
