Patrick Joseph Kearney, 63, of Hamden passed away peacefully on St. Valentine's Day, February 14, 2026 surrounded by his loving family after a courageous battle with cancer. Most recently, he completed 15 years of dedicated service as a case manager with Elevance Health. Patrick was a devout Catholic and parishioner of St. Paul VI Parish where he completed the

Alpha Program. He graduated from the Archdiocese of Hartford Catholic Biblical School 2-year program in Basic Biblical Studies and 4-year program in Advanced Biblical Studies. Patrick liked to read the Bible, psalms and countless religious books to enrich his faith. He prayed the rosary daily. He was an avid chess player and marathon runner.
