June 7, 1941 - August 15, 2024

Patrick Joseph Keogh, 83, passed away peacefully on Thursday, August 15, 2024, in his home surrounded by his loving family. Patrick was born in Portarlinton, County Offaly, Ireland on June 7, 1941, to the late Garrett and Dora Keogh and was the second of their seven children. During his childhood, he enjoyed playing in the bog fields and fishing and swimming in The River Barrow. He also loved the time he spent with his grandmother at her home in Annamoe as well spending summers with his aunts, uncles and cousins in the Wicklow mountains.

Patrick attended the Christian Brothers School in Portarlinton and moved to Manchester, England at the age of 17. He worked in Manchester for 5 years before emigrating to the United States in 1964. Shortly after arriving, Patrick enlisted in the U.S. Army and proudly served from 1964 to 1967. After his service, Patrick worked for Western Electric for several years before embarking upon a career as a Welding Foreman with Amtrak for over 30 years.

In his leisure time, Patrick loved being in The Catskill Mountains and playing golf with friends and family. When asked, he may have been known to exaggerate exactly how well his golf round went. He also enjoyed playing darts with his friends and will forever be remembered as an incredibly funny man and a great storyteller.

Patrick was the loving husband of 52 years to Anne Bohan Keogh. Besides his loving wife, he is survived by his 4 daughters: Doreen Busca (Sean), Katie Hice (Bill), Deirdre Ryan (Jim Laska) and Patricia Hinckley (Brandon). Additionally, Patrick is survived by his grandchildren Declan, Mairéad and Colm Ryan, and their father, Eamonn Ryan; Ronan and Neave Hinckley; and Olivia and Liam Hice. Patrick is also survived by his sisters Ann Byrne, Peg Whelan and Doreen Folan, sisters in-law Margaret Bohan, Mary Bohan, Mary Keogh, brother in-law Dick Whelan and many cherished nieces, nephews, family and friends. In addition to his parents, Patrick was predeceased by his brothers John, Brian and Garry Keogh and his infant granddaughter, Delaney Busca.

As we would say in Offaly he was "a great chap".

He was dedicated to his work. I never once heard him curse and he had a great sense of humour.

He went to school at Portarlinton CBS. He was an altar boy at St. Michaels church and he played the part of a shepherd in a Christmas play staged by Brother O Regan where he had to sing a Christmas Carol. We all went to see him perform.

My mother got a real Shepherds crook especially made for him in the local garage.

Paddy loved the outdoors and animals. He never came home to Ireland without paying a visit to Madeline Murphy who for many years lived next door to us in Patrick Street. They wrote to each other over the years and Madeline always gave him the news from home.

He never neglected sending me a St Patricks Day card and one at Easter and Christmas. He really loved Ireland.

My mother had great devotion to Our Lady so its not surprising that he passed to his eternal reward on August 15th (Feast of the Assumption) and his funeral Mass will be celebrated on August 21st (Feast of Our Lady Queen of Ireland) which happens to be Dicks and my 63rd wedding anniversary.

I will close by copying an Irish Blessing Paddy sent to me some years ago.
