“ Dear Family. I am very sorry to read of Peter's death. Pete was my father's and my friend and barber from 1952 when he started in the red house in the middle of the block on Chapel Street before we moved to the corner shop at Chapel and Grove Street next to Howard Service Center, until he decided to retire to play more golf. This was about 50 years later. My father Seymour and I would go together on a Saturday so that I could get an "estimate" on finding my ears under my long blond hair. I remember Pete had his first brush hanging on the wall dated 1952 and his appointment blackboard with the big mirrors on each wall. Also the picture of Lori with the baby bottle feeding her first child. The kid never got older and Lori was as beautiful as always. Pete had the trap door to the basement at the back of the shop that he hid the dustpan and broom for clean ups after each client. There was never any waiting, since everyone made an appointment in advance. If you just dropped in, you waited in either the outer or inner seating area with the chrome coat / hat rack near the front door. I miss going to the shop, since it had so many memories for me and I still think of it every time I need to go for an "estimate" at another barber shop.
