



Robert N. Reynolds, Jr.

November 4, 1953 - January 27, 2025

Robert N. Reynolds Jr., 71, of Hamden, passed away peacefully after a long illness on Monday, January 27, 2025. Born in New Haven on November 4, 1953, he was the beloved son of Marilyn A. (Dinnean) Reynolds and Dr. Robert N. Reynolds. Bob is survived by his four loving children, Robert III, Ryan, Eli and Daisy Reynolds. He is also survived by his sister Cathy (Rod) Swift, brothers Peter (Claudia) and William Reynolds, and sister Maureen (Will) Musco. Bob grew up in Hamden, attending St. Rita's Elementary School before going on to Hamden High School, where he played hockey and earned his lifelong moniker, Chopper. He earned his undergraduate degree in marketing from Nichols College, and his Juris Doctor from the University of Bridgeport Law School in 1981. He went on to practice law for 20 years and was a partner at Gaffney, Kane, and Reynolds; specializing in real estate, civil litigation, and business-related matters. In 2002, Bob turned to entrepreneurship, founding Shake-Away, a manufacturing and distribution business in the lawn and garden sector. He enjoyed summers spent at his family's cottage in Madison where he waterskied, sailed and enjoyed many an outing with family and neighbors. His summer buddies turned into his lifelong friends. He was an avid runner, completing the Marine Corps and Bar Harbor marathons, and countless New Haven Road Races. An avid golfer, he was a longtime member of the New Haven Country Club. In 2017, Bob was diagnosed with Lewy Body Dementia. His sons, Bobby and Ryan, cared for him selflessly during these years. Despite the decline in his cognitive function,

his will and spirit remained in him, a wry smile often flashing across his face at the mention of an old college pal or the suggestion of a late-night snack. Bob, an exceptionally proud parent, enjoyed attending Eli's football games and Daisy's track meets. We are especially appreciative of Tyler Benson who was a tremendous support to Bob over the past few years and to the group of loving caretakers to whom we are forever grateful.

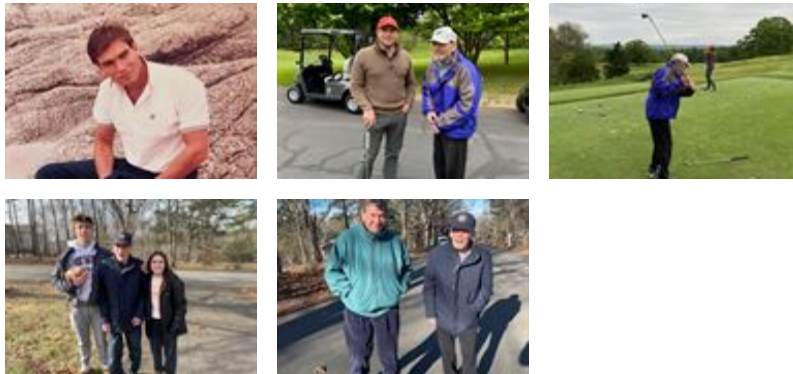
