Rosemary Joan (Holmes) Brennan, wife of the late Martin J Brennan, passed away on December 28, 2024. Rosemary was born in Danbury, CT on February 2, 1929. She was the daughter of the late Lewis C. Holmes and the late Mary A. Shannon Holmes; sister to the late Lewis C. Holmes Jr. and to the late Robert J. Holmes; and mother to the late Martin J Brennan, Jr. She is survived by her children, Susan Brennan of Southington, CT, Thomas and Lynn Brennan of Orleans, MA and Joan and David DiVincenzo of Hamden, CT. and by several nieces and nephews. Family was everything to Rosemary. She adored her seven grandchildren, Jack Brennan, Mary Kate Brennan, Daniel Brennan, Michael DiVincenzo, Mallory DiVincenzo, Chris Brennan and JR Brennan. She delighted in watching her four great-grandchildren, Henry Wehrman, Colin Brennan, Graham Brennan and Maeve Wehrman. 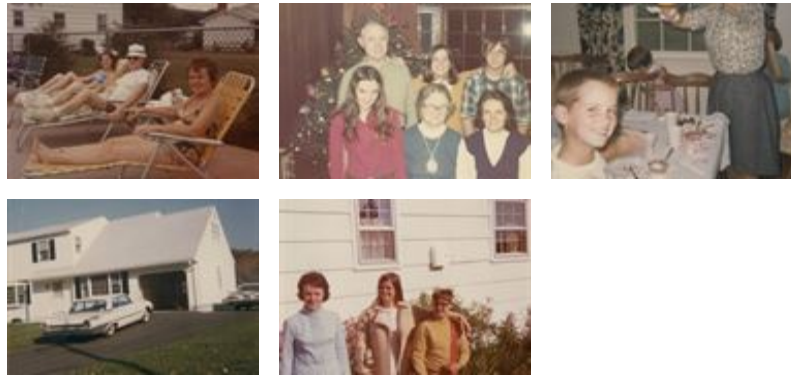

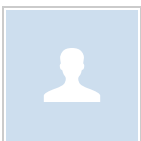
