Salvatore DePrimo Jr, age 90, of St. Petersburg, FL, and formerly of Hamden, CT, passed away peacefully on December 21, 2024, in Largo, FL, surrounded by his loving family. Born on October 26, 1934, in New Haven, CT, he was the son of the late Salvatore and Annunziata “Nancy” (Amento) DePrimo.

Salvatore was a devoted man of God whose faith and love touched everyone he knew.
