To Billy's family and friends, I give my deepest, most heartfelt condolences on your loss.

I was lucky enough to work with "Ku" at the Stop & Shop Dist. Center. I didn't get to work side-by-side with him for very long, but once we made a connection, he was always warm, friendly and extremely helpful. It turned out that I'd graduated from Notre Dame H.S. the same year as his brother John, and we had several mutual friends.

At that time, I was still a relative "new guy", and more than once, Billy had the right answer or the best advice. One especially long night during my probationary period as a selector, he was behind me in line at the desk where we'd pick up our next order. I got a huge order that would have taken me hours to complete. I was exhausted and sore, and discouraged because I was having problems maintaining the labor standard we were required to meet. Bill took the order out of my hand, tore off the last half of the order, and got on his pallet jack to start his next order as well as half of mine. I tried to take at least some of the pages back, but he wouldn't consider it.

Billy was all heart, and the lessons I got from seeing his work ethic and insight have stayed with me.

I heard a in eulogy once that, "In the end, we actually die three times; first when we stop breathing; again when we're lowered into the ground; and the third is the last time someone speaks our name".

I'm sure everyone that he knew has a Billy Kuchar story similar to mine that they could tell, so I'm certain he will live in all of us for a long time.
