William W. McDonald Jr., 89, of Hamden, CT died peacefully, surrounded by family, on St. Patrick's Day, March 17, 2016. Bill was born on December 12, 1926, in New Haven, Connecticut, the son of William W. McDonald, Sr. and Frances Marsh McDonald. He was a devoted husband, father, brother and friend and was well-loved for his sense of humor and caring, sensitive nature. A graduate of Hamden High School class of 1945, Bill was a veteran of WWII and served as an Army clerk in the Philippines. He returned to the States where he graduated from UConn with a BS in Business and life-long friendships with his fraternity brothers of Alpha Gamma Rho. After college, Bill made a name for himself as an affable and trustworthy salesman for Moran Brush Company and dozens of other industrial supply companies. He was always ready with a quick joke and made friends wherever he went.
